Dear Members,

To assist members with the timely payment of 2010 dues, the Board is again sending this stand-alone mailing along with a pre-addressed envelope for you to mail your payment.

Timely collection of dues is crucial to the Club. We depend on dues to meet our operating expenses, which are significant at the beginning of the season. In addition, processing dues payments and updating our membership records require considerable time. For these reasons, the Board is again requiring that dues payments be **postmarked or made via PayPal by May 1, 2010**. Payments after that date are subject to late fees detailed in the enclosed 2010 Dues and Membership Form.

- Dues are unchanged at \$500 for Full and Seasonal members and \$200 and \$75 for babysitters and additional children, respectively. The senior citizen and early payment discounts as well as the late fees are also the same as last year.
- Dues may be paid by check or PayPal (via www.cheverlypool.com). Make checks payable to “Cheverly Swim and Racquet Club” and mail to the address below. **Payments will not be accepted at the Front Desk -- even after the pool opens for the season!**
- Please complete the enclosed **2010 Dues and Membership Form** and include it with your check. If you use PayPal, please still mail in the form.
- Members whose payments are postmarked or made via PayPal by **May 1, 2010** may use the Club on Opening Day. Entry on Opening Day is not guaranteed if payment is postmarked or made after May 1, 2010.
